A	The following symptoms of those patients who have coldness and pain in the low back and a high urine output: Low back pain, cold low back, and nocturnal enuresis
B	The following symptoms of those patients with general malaise, lower back pain, cold feeling, sensation of heaviness, increased urinary frequency and output: Cold lower back, lower back pain, sciatica, and nocturnal enuresis
C	The following symptoms of those patients who have severe coldness in the low back and the lower limbs, coldness and pain in the low back, malaise, increased urinary frequency and urinary output: Sciatica, low back pain, nocturnal enuresis, enuresis, and leukorrhea
